To recognise that 26% of households in Ludlow do not own a car and improve provision for pedestrians and cyclists

### 8. Transport Hub

Train station/bus station/car parking/toilets, café at Galdeford car park (long term)

Discussed in relation to their existing use such as TiCL App and raising awareness of this geolocating app that guides visitors around Ludlow

The possibility of a geo-locating problem reporting app was also discussed as an effective way of reporting road and pavement defects.
