THE PREVENTION OF HARM TO CHILDREN

TO PREVENT PUBLIC NUISANCE

The application proposes selling alcohol until 2:30am at weekends and 1:30am during the week. I have faith in the current management of Crest Hotels and know that they do not want the hotel to become a focus on antisocial behaviour. However, management could change. We must carefully manage the night time economy of Ludlow town centre, which is a densely populated residential district, unlike the town centres of some other market towns. Festivals and holidays aside, the Compasses on Corve Street has the latest time for serving alcohol, 1:30am except on Sundays when sales must stop at midnight. There is a danger that customers will leave the Compasses when it closes and cross the road to the Feathers. Piling out the Feathers as late as 3:00am, they will then disturb residents of Corve Street and other residents. This will be a public nuisance. The opening hours should be the same as the Compasses.

TO PREVENT CRIME & DISORDER

My objection on crime and disorder is as stated above under public nuisance.
