

PROPOSAL FOR SAFE MARKET AND STALL LAYOUT:

In line with government guidelines set out in their recently published 'Safer Public Places', regarding street markets

- Every other stall being used so customers are spread out and allows for short queues (see diagram below)
- zig zag design allows stall holders safety from other stallholders
- cordoned area in red with cones and tape to control customer movement
- designated signed single entrance with queue marking
- Signing and information provided at widened entrance point
- designated signed single exit
- one way movement within market area
- controlled number of customers entering market area (managed by staff/volunteer on entrance)
- no trailers/ gazebos
- no hot food to go
- suitable social distancing signage
- encourage stallholders to use contactless payments
- encourage stallholders to receive pre orders
- Signs throughout the market on social distancing and circulation
- Queue markings for street stalls
